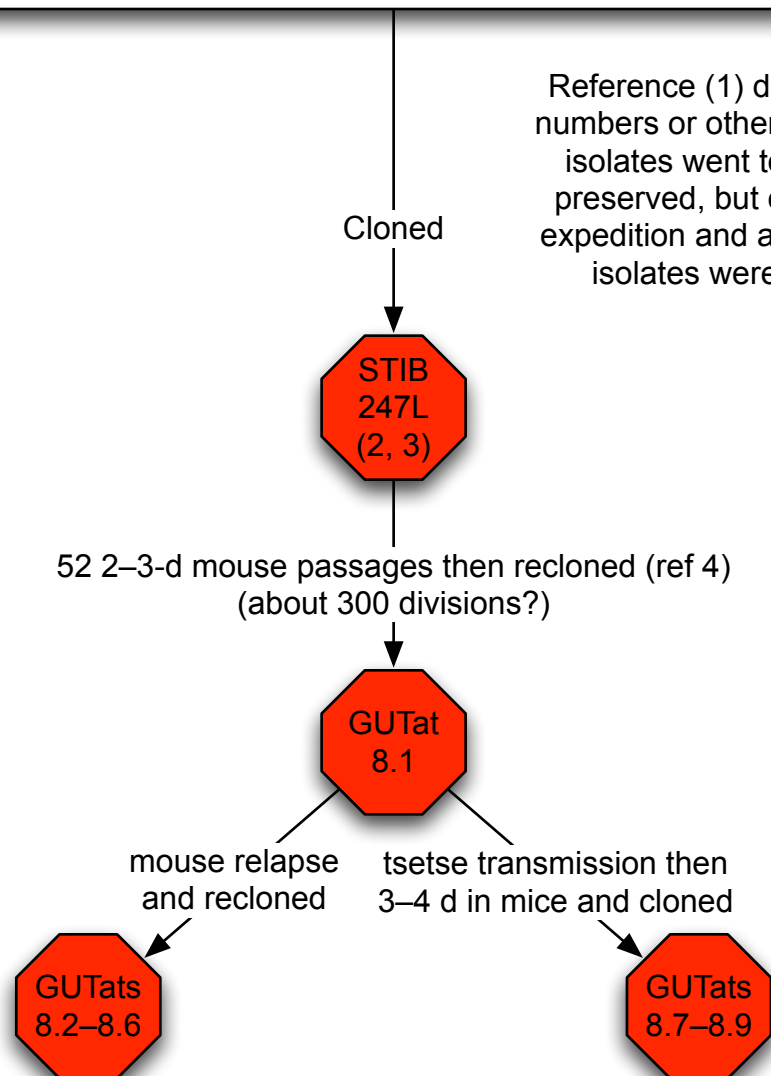


Probably from Hartebeest in Serengeti in 1971 (ref 1),
injected into rats and frozen as STIB 247 after unknown
number of days, but probably similar to procedures for STIB
246, for which I have a copy of the original stabilate record.
